Note verbale dated 9 June 2016 from the Permanent Mission of Norway to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Norway has the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2270 (2016), in particular its paragraph 40, in which the Council called upon all States to report within 90 days of the adoption of the resolution, and thereafter upon request by the Committee, on concrete measures that they had taken in order to implement effectively the provisions of the resolution.

The Government of Norway would like to inform the Committee that Norway has revised its applicable national regulations in order to implement the provisions of the resolution. In addition, Norway has chosen to implement measures corresponding to the European Union's restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

To this end, Council Regulation (EC) No. 329/2007 has been adapted and made part of the Norwegian regulation on sanctions and restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. Accordingly, the national regulation implements all relevant Security Council resolutions and also includes the additional European Union autonomous measures.

Please be assured that Norway will take an active approach to ensure the effective implementation of the provisions of resolution 2270 (2016).
