Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 2 August 2016 from the Permanent Mission of Costa Rica to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

By paragraph 40 of resolution 2270 (2016), the Security Council urged all Member States to report to the Council, within 90 days from the adoption of the resolution, and thereafter as requested by the Committee, on the concrete measures taken to effectively implement the provisions of the resolution.

The Government of the Republic of Costa Rica has taken due note of the adoption of resolution 2270 (2016) under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations and endorses all the provisions indicated in that resolution, and the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Costa Rica has duly informed the relevant national authorities of the obligations under resolution 2270 (2016).

In this regard, the Government of the Republic of Costa Rica wishes to inform the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) that many of the provisions of the resolution are being implemented through regulations and policies in the country and there is a review in process of the legal regulations for the implementation of the remaining provisions of the resolution at hand.

The Government of the Republic of Costa Rica will present a detailed report to the Committee on the concrete measures taken to implement the remaining provisions, as soon as the internal process has been completed.
