



Report of San Marino on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2371 (2017)

As with past resolutions concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of San Marino has taken steps to implement the provisions contained in resolution 2371 (2017).

Measures adopted through Security Council resolutions become enforceable in San Marino through decisions of the Congress of State (Government), which provides a list of the measures to be enforced and mandates the San Marino competent authorities to implement them.

On 28 August 2017, the San Marino Congress of State adopted Decision number 8, "Provisions implementing the measures adopted by the United Nations Security Council with respect to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea", along with the annexes thereto:¹

- 1. "Measures adopted by the United Nations Security Council with respect to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea";
- 2. "The list established and maintained pursuant to Security Council resolution 1718 (2006)";

All future changes made to the list of entities and individuals established and maintained by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) will be posted on a dedicated section of the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of San Marino within one working day of the receipt of the relevant notice from the Committee.
