

## Report of Chile on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016)

The Government of Chile has the honour to submit this report on its implementation of the provisions of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016), in accordance with paragraph 36 of that resolution. Chile was a sponsor of resolution 2321 (2016).

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Chile issued Decree No. 9 of 10 January 2017, which provides that all State authorities and bodies shall, within their respective powers, ensure the full and strict implementation of the provisions of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016), including by disseminating the names of the persons and entities and the list of items designated in annexes I, II, III and IV of the resolution as being subject to the travel ban, the export ban or asset-freezing measures.

With regard to paragraph 11 of resolution 2321 (2016), Chile does not engage in scientific or technical cooperation programmes with persons or groups officially sponsored by or representing the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

With regard to paragraphs 14 and 16 of the resolution, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea does not have diplomatic missions or consular posts in Chile.

With regard to paragraph 31 of resolution 2321 (2016), there are no banking institutions, or branches or representative offices thereof, from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea in Chile.
