



Report of Brunei Darussalam on the implementation of Security Council resolutions 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016)

- 1. The Government of Brunei Darussalam takes note of the adoption of Security Council resolutions 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK).
- 2. Prior to these, Brunei Darussalam submitted its initial report on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1718 (2006) in April 2008. Then in August 2011, Brunei Darussalam submitted its second national report on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1874 (2009).
- 3. With the present report, Brunei Darussalam conveys its commitment to implementing the provisions of Security Council resolutions 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016) in accordance with its relevant domestic laws. In this regard, Brunei Darussalam is pleased to report that all of its relevant national agencies have been informed of their obligations, including highlights of the main operative paragraphs.
- 4. To carry out its international obligations, Brunei Darussalam has in place the following legislation:
 - Customs Order, 2006
 - Arms and Explosives Act
 - Arms and Explosives Rules
 - Merchant Shipping Order, 2002
 - Autoriti Monetari Brunei Darussalam Order, 2010
 - Anti-Terrorism Order, 2011
 - Criminal Asset Recovery Order, 2012
 - Immigration Act
 - Finance Companies Act
- 5. Brunei Darussalam established diplomatic relations with DPRK on 7 January 1999, but bilateral cooperation is minimal. As to financial and trade activities with DPRK, Brunei Darussalam reiterates that they are minimal to nil.
- 6. Brunei Darussalam continues to support all efforts to ensure peace, stability and the denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula through peaceful and constructive dialogue.
