

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 27 April 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Liechtenstein to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and has the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2321 (2016), adopted on 30 November 2016, in which the Security Council called upon all States to report on the implementation of the resolution.

On 6 December 2016 and 7 March 2017 the Government of Liechtenstein amended the Government Ordinance on Measures concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2016, No. 196) with a view to implementing the United Nations sanctions established in Security Council resolution 2321 (2016). Liechtenstein has fully implemented the measures contained in the resolution. Violations are punishable in accordance with criminal law. The above-mentioned Ordinance is regularly updated following relevant decisions by the sanctions Committee.

Implementation is smooth and does not currently pose any particular difficulty. The Government of Liechtenstein is fully committed to maintaining this high level of implementation and to keeping the measures taken under review, as necessary.
