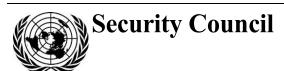

Report of the Philippines on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017)

- 1. The Philippines supports the adoption of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017) and the provisions contained therein.
- 2. The Philippines welcomes the positive developments on the Korean Peninsula, in particular the plans for an inter-Korean summit, and the willingness of parties to undertake constructive dialogue.
- 3. In compliance with the resolution, the agencies responsible for implementing resolution 2397 (2017) have been consulted and required to submit compliance reports.
- 4. A list of individuals, entities and vessels subject to an asset freeze, a travel ban and vessel seizure has been circulated to the relevant implementing agencies.
- 5. The Department of National Defense, within the ambit of its mandate, duties and policies, monitors vessels, aircraft, train lines and vehicles that may be used for the sale or transfer of goods and items that are prohibited under resolution 2397 (2017) and previous Security Council resolutions on the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.
- 6. The Civil Aeronautics Board does not accept any application for the issuance of a foreign air carrier permit to carriers originating in the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and does not process applications for routes that include any destination within the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.
