Report of Belarus on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017)

In accordance with paragraph 17 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017), the Republic of Belarus has the honour to report the following.

The provisions of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017) have been brought to the attention of the relevant State authorities in the Republic of Belarus and, in accordance with domestic law, have been taken up by them for guidance in their work.

We further inform you that in December 2017, the Republic of Belarus took measures leading to the departure of Kim Sou Kwang (also known as Kim Soukwang and Kim Su Gwang), born in 1976, a confirmed operative of the Reconnaissance General Bureau of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

Belarus remains committed to fulfilling its international obligations, including by implementing the resolutions of the Security Council.
