Note verbale dated 6 August 2019 from the Permanent Mission of Sri Lanka to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka to the United Nations in New York presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) and has the honour to refer to paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017) on the repatriation to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea of all nationals of that country earning income in another Member State's jurisdiction, including all government safety oversight attachés of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea monitoring workers from that country who are abroad.

In this regard, the Mission is pleased to inform the Committee that, according to the records of the Department of Immigration and Emigration of Sri Lanka, since 2017 no nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea have been repatriated and there are no nationals of that country subject to repatriation in the future under the terms of paragraph 8 of resolution 2397 (2017).
