Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 6 November 2019 from the Permanent Mission of Nepal to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Nepal to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) and, with reference to resolution 2397 (2017) and other related resolutions, has the honour to report on the following measures taken by the Government of Nepal in order to effectively implement the provisions of the resolutions.

First, as ordered by the immigration authority of Nepal, 33 nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea had already left the territory of Nepal as at 31 October 2019. The visa issued to nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea living in Nepal was valid until 31 October 2019. Accordingly, those still living in Nepal illegally would be subject to prosecution under the country's immigration laws.

Second, the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Supplies notified all business entities in which nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea had invested to start, before 15 August 2019, the process of closing down those businesses.

Lastly, the investors in and the authorized representatives of the business entities in which nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea had invested were notified with a view to ensuring that all the business transactions pertaining to their industries ceased before 31 October 2019.
