

## Report of Chile on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017)

Pursuant to paragraph 8 of resolution 2397 (2017) regarding the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Government of Chile wishes to transmit the following information provided by the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security.

In the period from 2005 to 2014, the Government of Chile issued 63 visas conditional on the existence of a contract to citizens of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. This type of visa is granted to foreigners travelling to Chile in order to fulfil an employment contract. Since 2014, the Government of Chile has not granted any visas of this type to nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

Breakdown of visas granted in the period from 2005 to 2014:
