## Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

## Note verbale dated 14 January 2021 from the Permanent Mission of New Zealand to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of New Zealand to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) and transmits herewith its report.

New Zealand is committed to the effective implementation of Security Council resolutions adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations concerning sanctions imposed on the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

In paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017), the Council required all Member States to provide within 27 months of the adoption of the resolution a final report on all nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea earning income in that Member State's jurisdiction that had been repatriated over the 24-month period starting from the date of the adoption of the resolution.

After examining its immigration records, New Zealand confirms that there were no persons within its jurisdiction covered by that paragraph and therefore no persons have been repatriated to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea within the specified time period.
