**Report of India on the implementation of Security Council
resolution 2048 (2012)**

The Government of India published an Order dated 30 June 2016 on the implementation of the Security Council resolution on Guinea-Bissau in the Gazette of India.¹ The Order was published in order to incorporate into Indian domestic law the sanctions against Guinea-Bissau established by the Security Council in its resolution 2048 (2012).

Travel ban

The Order prevents the entry into or transit through Indian territory of individuals designated by the Committee and provides that it is not obligatory for the Government of India to refuse the entry of its own nationals into its territory. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the above-mentioned resolution.
