THE SITUATION CONCERNING WESTERN SAHARA

REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL (S/21360)

The PRESIDENT (interpretation from French): The Security Council is meeting in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

Members of the Council have before them the report of the Secretary-General on the situation concerning Western Sahara, which is contained in document S/21360, and Corr.1, where applicable. Members of the Council also have before them document S/21376, which contains the text of a draft resolution prepared in the course of the Council's consultations.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. Unless I hear any objection, I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

There being no objection, it is so decided.

I shall now call on those members of the Council who wish to make statements before the voting. Since no member wishes to speak, we shall proceed to the voting.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour: Canada, China, Colombia, Cote d'Ivoire, Cuba, Ethiopia, Finland, France, Malaysia, Romania, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Yemen, Zaïre

The PRESIDENT (interpretation from French): There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 658 (1990).
