Official communiqué of the 4132nd meeting of the Security Council

Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday, 25 April 2000, at 3.50 p.m.

At its 4132nd meeting, held in private on 25 April 2000, the Security Council considered the situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo. The representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo was invited, at his request, to participate in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

The Security Council heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Sir Ketumile Masire, Facilitator of the Inter-Congolese Dialogue.

The members of the Council made comments and posed questions in connection with the briefing.

The representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo made a statement.

Sir Ketumile Masire responded to the comments and questions posed by members of the Council.
