Official communiqué of the 4198th meeting of the Security Council

Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday, 19 September 2000, at 5 p.m.

The Security Council met in private at its 4198th meeting, held on 19 September 2000, in connection with the item entitled "The situation in East Timor", for the purpose of a briefing by the Government of Indonesia.

The President extended an invitation in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to His Excellency Mr. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, Special Envoy of the Government of Indonesia, Coordinating Minister for Political, Social and Security Affairs.

The members of the Council and His Excellency Mr. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono had a frank and constructive discussion about the need for early and full implementation of resolution 1319 (2000).
