Official communiqué of the 4313th meeting of the Security Council**Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters on Tuesday, 24 April 2001, at 10.35 a.m.**

At its 4313th meeting, held in private on 24 April 2001, the Security Council considered the item entitled “The situation in Georgia”.

In accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure, the President invited the Minister of Special Affairs of Georgia and the representative of Sweden to participate in the meeting.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Dieter Boden, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in Georgia.

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in Georgia briefed the Council.

The members of the Council, the Minister of Special Affairs of Georgia, the representative of Sweden (speaking on behalf of the European Union and associated States), and the Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in Georgia had a constructive discussion.
