**Official communiqué of the 4373rd (closed) meeting  
of the Security Council**

**Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters  
on Monday, 17 September 2001, at 3.30 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 4373rd meeting, held in private at 3.30 p.m. on 17 September 2001, the Security Council considered the item entitled “Briefing by His Excellency Nebojša Čović, Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia, Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.

“In accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure, the President extended an invitation to His Excellency Mr. Nebojša Čović, Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia, Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.

“In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Hans Haekkerup, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo.

“The members of the Security Council had a constructive interactive discussion with the Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia, Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, and the Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo.”
