Official communiqué of the 4571st (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday, 11 July 2002, at 12.25 p.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"At its 4571st meeting, held in private on 11 July 2002, the Security Council considered the item entitled 'The situation in the Central African Republic'.

"The President, with the consent of the members of the Council, invited General Lamine Cissé, Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Peace-building Support Office in the Central African Republic to participate in the discussion of the item, in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The Security Council heard a briefing by General Lamine Cissé.

"The members of the Council and General Cissé had a constructive discussion."
