Official communiqué of the 5009th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday, 23 July 2004, at 11.45 a.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 23 July 2004, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 5009th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUC).

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. William Lacy Swing, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

“The members of the Council had a constructive exchange of views with representatives of participating troop-contributing countries.”
