Official communiqué of the 5087th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Wednesday,
24 November 2004, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 24 November 2004, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 5087th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH).

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Juan Gabriel Valdés, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti.

“Representatives of the participating troop-contributing countries, Mr. Valdés, and members of the Council had a constructive exchange of views.”
