Official communiqué of the 5174th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Wednesday,
4 May 2005, at 3.30 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 5174th meeting, held in private on 4 May 2005, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Georgia’.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Azerbaijan, Georgia and Germany to participate in the discussion of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Special Envoy of the President of Georgia, His Excellency Mr. Irakli Alasania, made a statement.”
