### **Official communiqué of the 5279th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,  
13 October 2005, at 4.35 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 5279th meeting, held in private on 13 October 2005, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Côte d’Ivoire’.
