Official communiqué of the 5310th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Monday,
28 November 2005, at 11.10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

On 28 November 2005, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 5310th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Operation in Burundi (ONUB).

The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard briefings under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Ms. Carolyn McAskie, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Burundi, and Major-General Derrick Mbuyiselo Mgwebi, Force Commander of the United Nations Operation in Burundi.

Members of the Council, Ms. McAskie, Major-General Mgwebi and representatives of participating troop-contributing countries had a constructive exchange of views.
