Official communiqué of the 5427th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday, 27 April 2006, at 10.40 a.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 5427th meeting, held in private on 27 April 2006, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Côte d’Ivoire’.

“Pursuant to the decision taken at the five thousand four hundred and twenty-sixth meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to His Excellency Mr. Charles Konan Banny, Prime Minister of Côte d’Ivoire.
