**Official communiqué of the 5755th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Wednesday,  
10 October 2007, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 10 October 2007, the Security Council, pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B, held its 5755th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti.

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard briefings under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Hédi Annabi, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti and by General Per Arne Five, Acting Military Adviser of the Department of Peacekeeping Operations.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Annabi, General Five and representatives of participating troop-contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
