Official communiqué of the 6294th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Wednesday, 7 April 2010, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 7 April 2010, the Security Council, pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B, held its 6294th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
