Official communiqué of the 6420th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,
11 November 2010, at 11.30 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 11 November 2010, the Security Council, pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B, held its 6420th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in the Sudan.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police- contributing countries heard briefings under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Haile Menkerios, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in the Sudan, and Major General Moses Obi, Force Commander of the United Nations Mission in the Sudan, via video teleconference.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Menkerios, Major General Obi and representatives of participating troop- and police-contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
