Official communiqué of the 6436th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
7 December 2010, at 9 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 7 December 2010, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6436th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Operation in Côte d’Ivoire.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Abou Moussa, Principal Deputy Special Representative of the Secretary-General of the United Nations Operation in Côte d’Ivoire, via video teleconference.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Abou Moussa and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
