Official communiqué of the 6543rd (closed) meeting of the Security Council**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday, 3 June 2011, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 3 June 2011, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6543rd meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
