Members of the Council have before them document S/2011/636, containing the text of a draft resolution submitted by Portugal.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2011/609, containing a letter dated 30 September 2011 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council.

The President: There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2013 (2011).

The Security Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda. The Council will remain seized of the matter.
