

Official communiqué of the 6689th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday, 15 December 2011, at 11.15 a.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"At its 6689th meeting, held in private on 15 December 2011, the Security Council considered the item entitled 'Reports of the Secretary-General on the Sudan'.

"Pursuant to the decision taken at the 6688th meeting, the President recognized the presence at the Council table of the representative of the Sudan, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Hungary, Israel, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Malaysia, Norway, Poland, Qatar, Spain, Swaziland and Switzerland, at their request, to participate in the consideration without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"Pursuant to the decision taken at the 6688th meeting, the President recognized the presence at the Council table of Mr. Luis Moreno-Ocampo, Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court, in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The members of the Council and Mr. Moreno-Ocampo had an exchange of views."
