Official communiqué of the 6958th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
30 April 2013, at 11.12 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 6958th meeting, held in private on 30 April 2013, the Security Council considered the item entitled “Implementation of the note by the President of the Security Council (S/2010/507)”.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Albania, Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Cameroon, Chile, Colombia, Cuba, Denmark, Djibouti, Estonia, Ethiopia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, India, Indonesia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Ireland, Japan, Kenya, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Mozambique, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Niger, Norway, Peru, the Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the Syrian Arab Republic, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkey and the United Republic of Tanzania to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to the representative of the Delegation of the European Union to the United Nations.

“In accordance with the provisional rules of procedure and the previous practice in this regard, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation to the representative of the Observer State of the Holy See to the United Nations, to participate in this meeting.

“In accordance with the provisional rules of procedure and the previous practice in this regard, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation to the representative of the Observer State of Palestine, to participate in this meeting.

“The members of the Council had an exchange of views.”
