Official communiqué of the 7424th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
8 April 2015, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 8 April 2015, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 7424th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic.

“The President invited General Babacar Gaye, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by General Gaye, via video-teleconference from Bangui.

“Members of the Council, General Gaye and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
