Official communiqué of the 7437th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
5 May 2015, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 5 May 2015, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 7437th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

“The President invited Mr. Edmond Mulet, Assistant Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by Mr. Mulet.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Mulet and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
