Letter dated 27 January 2017 from the Panel of Experts on Yemen addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2017/81)

Members of the Council have before them document S/2017/142, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
