The President: On behalf of the members of the Security Council, I would like to condemn in the strongest terms the cowardly terrorist attack that took place in London on 22 March and resulted in the death or serious injury of many innocent people. I would also like to express my sincere condolences to the families of the victims.

I now invite Council members to rise to observe a minute of silence in tribute to the memory of the victims of yesterday's attack and all other victims of terrorism throughout the world.
