#### **Report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force (S/2021/994)**

**The President** (*spoke in French*): The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2021/1077, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by the Russian Federation and the United States of America.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2021/994, which contains the report
