### **Official communiqué of the 9049th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday, 27 May 2022, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 9049th meeting, held in private on 27 May 2022, the Security Council considered the item entitled “The situation in Myanmar”.

“The President invited the representative of Cambodia to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The President invited Ms. Noeleen Heyzer, Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for Myanmar, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Council heard briefings by His Excellency Mr. Prak Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Cambodia, in his capacity as Special Envoy of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Chair on Myanmar, and Ms. Heyzer.

“Statements were made by the representatives of the United Kingdom, Albania, France, Ireland, Norway, the Russian Federation, Gabon, China, the United Arab Emirates, Mexico, Brazil, Ghana, Kenya, India and by the President, speaking in her capacity as the representative of the United States.

“His Excellency Mr. Prak Sokhonn and Ms. Heyzer responded to comments and questions raised.”
