Official communiqué of the 9279th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Monday, 13 March 2023, at 3 p.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"At its 9279th meeting, held in private on 13 March 2023, the Security Council considered the item entitled 'The situation in Myanmar'.

"The President invited the representative of Indonesia to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The President invited Ms. Noeleen Heyzer, Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for Myanmar, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The Council heard briefings by Ms. Heyzer, and by Her Excellency Ms. Retno Marsudi, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Indonesia, in her capacity as Chair of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).

"Statements were made by the representatives of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the United States of America, the Russian Federation, Switzerland, France, Brazil, China, Gabon, Japan, Ghana, Ecuador, the United Arab Emirates, Malta, Albania, and by the President, speaking in his capacity as the representative of Mozambique.

"Ms. Heyzer and Her Excellency Ms. Marsudi responded to comments and questions raised."
