## Administrative instruction

## Normal working hours at Headquarters

- 1. The Under-Secretary-General for Management Strategy, Policy and Compliance, for the purpose of implementing staff rule 1.4, promulgates the following:
- 2. The normal working week in New York is five days of eight and one-half hours during the main part of the regular session of the General Assembly, and eight hours at all other times, with a break of one hour for lunch. Except for staff on authorized absences or sick leave, all staff must be present during a "core period" from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., the lunch hour beginning not earlier than 11.30 a.m. and ending not later than 3 p.m. The remaining regular hours of work may be scheduled at any time before, after, or partly before and partly after, the core period.
- 3. The normal working week is subject to exceptions when staff members have been authorized to avail themselves of flexible working arrangements, in accordance with the Secretary-General's bulletin on flexible working arrangements (ST/SGB/2019/3).
