Secretary-General's bulletin

Central review bodies

For the purpose of implementing staff rule 4.15 and in light of an increased number of vacancies requiring review by the central review bodies, additional alternates to the central review bodies may be nominated to advise on the appointment and promotion of staff. Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2002/6 is therefore amended as follows:

In section 2, entitled "Composition of the Central Review Boards", the following text is added as subparagraph 2.1 (d):

"(d) For an initial period of two years, up to ten additional alternates may be selected by the Secretary-General and up to ten additional alternates may be selected by the staff representative body concerned to serve on the Central Review Board in New York and other locations, as may be necessary."

In section 3, entitled "Composition of the Central Review Committees", the following text is added as subparagraph 3.1 (d):

"(d) For an initial period of two years, up to ten additional alternates may be selected by the Secretary-General and up to ten additional alternates may be selected by the staff representative body concerned to serve on the Central Review Committee in New York and other locations, as may be necessary."

The present bulletin shall enter into force on the date of its issuance.
