Item 1

Opening of the meeting

1. The sixteenth meeting of the Persistent Organic Pollutants Review Committee will be held from 11 to 16 January 2021. Owing to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, it is not possible for participants to meet face to face in Geneva or in Rome as had originally been planned. The meeting will therefore, as an exceptional measure, be conducted online. The meeting will be opened by the interim Chair of the Committee, Mr. Peter Dawson (New Zealand), at 12 noon (Geneva time (UTC+1)) on Monday, 11 January 2021.
