Letter dated 4 November 1968 from the Permanent Representative of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 27 September 1988 (A/43/649-5/20204), I have the honour to report to you the following incident in violation of **Pakistan** territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 3 November 1988:

On 3 Novrmber 1988, at 1002 hours, two SU-22 aircraft of the Kabul régime violated Pakietan airspace and penetrated to a depth of eight nautical miles near Thal, The intruding aircraft were engaged by the Pakistan Air Force and as a consequence one aircraft of the Kabul régime was shot down on Pakietan soil - North West of Village Manduri in the Thal area. The Afghan pilot has been captured and is presently in the custody of the Government of Pakistan,
