Algeria

1. In a note verbale dated 5 April 2011, the Permanent Mission of Algeria to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that:

During the 2010/11 academic year, 950 Western Saharan students are receiving training provided by Algeria. The scholarships are in the following fields of study:

- (a) 645 scholarships in the arts and humanities;
- (b) 305 scholarships in science.

Given that the Government of Algeria granted a total of 803 scholarships last year, this means that there was an increase of 18.30 per cent this year.

Philippines

2. In a note verbale dated 21 March 2011, the Permanent Mission of the Philippines to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that the Philippines sponsors or co-sponsors a number of scholarships for some Non-Self-Governing Territories. These include:
