Fifth paragraph

For the existing text *substitute*

In order to respect the principle of the “negotiation line”, which has not yet been reached through indirect negotiations, it cannot be claimed that there is an established Israeli exclusive economic zone, contrary to what the Israeli side has claimed regarding the so-called Karish field. That claim prompted Lebanon to formally object in the identical letters dated 18 September 2021 from the Permanent Representative of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and to the President of the Security Council ([A/76/351-S/2021/812](#)) to any drilling in the disputed areas so as to avoid taking measures that could pose a threat to international peace and security.
