Letter dated 3 June 2010 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and Chad (MINURCAT), which was established by Security Council resolution 1778 (2007) of 25 September 2007.

I should like to inform you that it is my intention to appoint Mr. Youssef Mahmoud (Tunisia) as my Special Representative for MINURCAT, from 1 June to 31 December 2010. Mr. Mahmoud has been serving as my Acting Special Representative since 1 April 2010. He will succeed Mr. Victor da Silva Angelo (Portugal), who served as my Special Representative for MINURCAT until 31 March 2010.
