## **Análisis del programa de la Asamblea General**

### **Nota de la Secretaría**

#### **I. Introducción**


1. En el párrafo 5 de la sección B del anexo de su resolución 58/126, de 19 de diciembre de 2003, la Asamblea General pidió al Presidente de la Asamblea General:  
“que [...] formule propuestas para seguir bienalizando, trienalizando, agrupando y eliminando temas del programa habitual de la Asamblea con miras a que la Mesa las examine a más tardar el 1º de abril de 2004.”
2. A petición del Presidente, la Secretaría ha preparado la presente nota para facilitar las deliberaciones sobre la cuestión.
3. El programa de la Asamblea General es un documento en constante evolución; todos los períodos de sesiones se añaden nuevos temas y subtemas, los títulos de los temas cambian de un período de sesiones a otro y los temas que ya no son pertinentes se eliminan.
4. La presente nota viene acompañada de los siguientes anexos:
  - I. Lista de todos los temas del programa
  - II. Lista de los temas de examen anual
  - III. Lista de los temas de examen bienal
  - IV. Lista de los temas de examen trienal
  - V. Lista de los temas de examen cuatrienal
  - VI. Lista de los temas de examen quinquenal
  - VII. Lista de los temas asignados a las sesiones plenarias que están inactivos



5. En total, el programa contiene 333 temas y subtemas. El número de temas asignados a cada una de las Comisiones Principales y a las sesiones plenarias como se muestra en el gráfico que aparece a continuación, es el siguiente:

7. Las listas de los temas del programa se han extraído de los documentos A/59/50, A/58/251, A/57/251/Rev.1, A/56/251/Rev.1 y A/55/251/Rev.1.

8. En los anexos, las columnas tituladas "Session" (período de sesiones) y "Year" (año) (véase el encabezamiento H) indican el momento en que el tema se incluyó en el programa y quién solicitó su inclusión.

9. La columna "Action history" (información sobre medidas adoptadas) (véase el encabezamiento I) contiene información del último período de sesiones en que se examinó el tema.
10. La columna titulada "No. of meetings" (número de sesiones) (véase el encabezamiento I) indica el número de sesiones que se asignaron al tema.
11. El número de oradores (columna titulada "No. of speakers", bajo el encabezamiento I) se refiere al último período de sesiones en que se examinó el tema.
12. En la comuna "No. of reports" (número de informes) (véase el encabezamiento I), los números que aparecen entre corchetes hacen referencia a las adiciones, y los asteriscos indican que el documento se publicó en relación con varios temas.
13. Los temas y subtemas que se indican a continuación son nuevos y todavía se desconoce su frecuencia, por lo que figuran como temas de examen anual.
- Prevención de conflictos armados (tema asignado a sesiones plenarias)
  - Cumplimiento de los acuerdos de limitación de armamentos y desarme y no proliferación (tema asignado a la Primera Comisión)
  - Aumento de la eficacia de los métodos de trabajo de la Primera Comisión (tema asignado a la Primera Comisión)
  - Medidas de fomento de la confianza en los planos regional y subregional (tema asignado a la Primera Comisión).

## II. Observaciones finales

14. Se espera que la información fáctica que se proporciona en la presente nota ayude a las delegaciones a encontrar formas de racionalizar el programa de la Asamblea General. Por ejemplo, entre los temas asignados a las sesiones plenarias, hay 10 que pueden considerarse inactivos; esto es, temas en relación con los cuales no se ha adoptado ninguna medida sustantiva en los últimos 10 años (véase el anexo VII). La Asamblea tal vez desee considerar si esos temas deben mantenerse en el programa, pero en una "lista de temas inactivos" para luego pasarse de nuevo al "programa de temas activos" cuando sea necesario. Los temas inactivos no son tan evidentes en el caso de los temas asignados a las Comisiones Principales.

15. También se podría considerar la posibilidad de dar un paso más. Como se señala en el documento A/58/CRP.4, el programa parece no encajar con las prioridades de la Organización. En lugar de intentar encontrar una estructura para incluir todos los temas, quizás habría que estudiar la posibilidad de una lista de temas del programa que se ajustara a las prioridades de la Organización indicadas en el plan de mediano plazo o a las definidas en la Declaración del Milenio. Una posibilidad sería distinguir, para cada período de sesiones en concreto, entre un programa permanente y un programa real. La ventaja de este planteamiento es que el programa real de cada período de sesiones permitiría poner de manifiesto las prioridades de las Naciones Unidas en ese momento en particular.

16. En el anexo II se enumeran todos los temas de examen anual incluidos en el programa de la Asamblea General. Esta lista podría examinarse para seguir bienalizando y trienalizando los temas y, lo que es igualmente importante, para agrupar los temas con el fin de consolidarlos y mejorar los debates sobre temas similares. Cabe

señalar que no en todas las Comisiones Principales se lleva a cabo la bienalización de los temas. Las Comisiones Tercera y Cuarta, por ejemplo, sólo tienen temas de examen anual.

17. Asimismo, se podría examinar el anexo III, en el que se indican todos los temas de examen bienal, y estudiar la posibilidad de trienalizar algunos.
