Étude de l'ordre du jour de l'Assemblée générale

Note du Secrétariat

I. Introduction

1. Au paragraphe 5 de la section B de l'annexe à sa résolution 58/126, en date du 19 décembre 2003, l'Assemblée générale a prié son Président :

« [...] de soumettre au Bureau, [...] le 1er avril 2004 au plus tard, des propositions en vue de favoriser la biennialisation, la triennialisation, le regroupement ou l'élimination de points de l'ordre du jour habituel de l'Assemblée. »

2. Le Secrétariat a établi la présente note, à la demande du Président, pour faciliter les débats sur cette question.

3. L'ordre du jour de l'Assemblée générale est un document évolutif: de nouveaux points et sous-points sont ajoutés à chaque session, les titres des points peuvent être modifiés d'une session à l'autre et certains points sont abandonnés lorsqu'ils ne sont plus pertinents.

4. La présente note comporte les annexes suivantes :



7. Les listes des points de l'ordre du jour ont été dressées à partir des documents A/59/50, A/58/251, A/57/251/Rev.1, A/56/251/Rev.1 et A/55/251/Rev.1.

8. En annexe, les colonnes « Session » et « Année » (voir la rubrique H) permettent de savoir quand et à la demande de qui un point a été inscrit à l'ordre du jour.

9. La colonne intitulée « Historique » (voir la rubrique I) offre des éléments d'information relatifs à la dernière session pendant laquelle le point a été examiné.

10. Le nombre de séances consacrées à un point donné de l'ordre du jour est indiqué dans la colonne « Nombre de séances » (voir la rubrique I).

11. Le nombre d'intervenants (voir la rubrique I) est celui de la dernière session au cours de laquelle chaque point a été examiné.

12. Dans la colonne « Nombre de rapports » (voir la rubrique I), les chiffres entre crochets renvoient au nombre d'additifs, et l'astérisque indique qu'un document a été publié au titre de plusieurs points.

13. Les points ou sous-points énumérés ci-après viennent d'être inscrits à l'ordre du jour et on ne sait donc pas avec quelle régularité ils seront examinés. Ils ont par conséquent été regroupés avec les points examinés chaque année :

- Prévention des conflits armés (Assemblée générale siégeant en plénière)
- Respect des accords de limitation des armements, de désarmement et de non-prolifération (point examiné par la Première Commission)
- Amélioration de l'efficacité des méthodes de travail de la Première Commission (point examiné par la Première Commission)
- Mesures de confiance à l'échelon régional et sous-régional (point examiné par la Première Commission)

II. Conclusions

14. Les données factuelles fournies dans la présente note devraient aider les délégations à rationaliser l'ordre du jour de l'Assemblée générale. Si l'on considère par exemple les points examinés par l'Assemblée siégeant en plénière, on se rend compte que 10 d'entre eux sont « en veilleuse », c'est-à-dire qu'ils n'ont fait l'objet d'aucune mesure de fond au cours des 10 dernières années (voir l'annexe VII). L'Assemblée générale souhaitera peut-être examiner si ces points, tout en restant inscrits à l'ordre du jour, doivent être regroupés sur une « liste d'attente », à partir de laquelle ils pourraient au besoin être réintégrés dans « l'ordre du jour actuel ». Les points en veilleuse des grandes commissions ne ressortent pas de manière aussi claire.

15. Une autre solution plus radicale est aussi envisageable. Comme indiqué dans le document A/58/CRP.4, il existe un écart entre l'ordre du jour et les priorités de l'Organisation. Au lieu d'essayer de mettre au point une structure abritant l'ensemble des points, on pourrait dresser une liste des points de l'ordre du jour tenant compte des priorités de l'Organisation telles qu'elles sont définies dans le plan à moyen terme ou la Déclaration du Millénaire. Une des formules possibles consisterait à établir, en parallèle de l'ordre du jour permanent, un ordre du jour

pour chaque session afin de refléter les priorités de l'Organisation des Nations Unies à ce moment-là.

16. La liste de tous les points de l'ordre du jour de l'Assemblée générale qui sont examinés chaque année est donnée à l'annexe II. Il serait souhaitable d'étudier cette liste pour déterminer si certains points ne pourraient pas être examinés tous les deux ou trois ans et, ce qui est tout aussi important, être regroupés, afin de combiner et d'améliorer les débats sur des points connexes. Il convient de noter que la biennalisation n'est pas pratiquée par toutes les grandes commissions. Ainsi, les points examinés par les Troisième et Quatrième Commissions le sont chaque année.

17. Il serait également souhaitable d'étudier la liste de tous les points examinés tous les deux ans, donnée à l'annexe III, pour déterminer si certains d'entre eux ne pourraient pas être examinés tous les trois ans.
