REVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS AND DECISIONS
ADOPTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ITS TENTH SPECIAL SESSION

Status of multilateral disarmament agreements

Report of the Secretary-General

1. By resolution 36/92 H of 9 December 1981, the General Assembly, *inter alia*, requested the Secretary-General to prepare for each regular session of the Assembly a composite table of signatories of and parties to multilateral disarmament agreements with a view to enabling the Assembly to take up the question of their status, if it deemed it appropriate.
2. Pursuant to the above resolution, the Secretary-General submits in the attached annex an updated composite table of signatories of and parties to multilateral disarmament agreements, as reported by the depositaries of those agreements. 1/

Notes

1/ The information contained in the present report reproduces data furnished by the Secretary-General where he is the depositary of the treaties or agreements concerned and by those Governments which are depositaries in other cases. Inclusion of information as to the treaties and agreements of which the Secretary-General is not the depositary is as reported by the respective depositaries.

The Secretary-General is the depositary of (a) the Convention on the Prohibition of Military or Any Other Hostile Use of Environmental Modification Techniques, (b) the Agreement Governing the Activities of States on the Moon and Other Celestial Bodies, and (c) the Convention on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Certain Conventional Weapons which May Be Deemed to Be Excessively Injurious or to Have Indiscriminate Effects.

Notes (continued)

France is the depositary of the Protocol for the Prohibition of the Use in War of Asphyxiating, Poisonous or Other Gases, and of Bacteriological Methods of Warfare.

Mexico is the depositary of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin American (Treaty of Tlatelolco).

The Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America are depositaries of (a) the Treaty Banning Nuclear Weapon Tests in the Atmosphere, in Outer Space and Under Water, (b) the Treaty on Principles Governing the Activities of States in the Exploration and Use of Outer Space, including the Moon and Other Celestial Bodies, (c) the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, (d) the Treaty on the Prohibition of the Emplacement of Nuclear Weapons and Other Weapons of Mass Destruction on the Sea-Bed and the Ocean Floor and in the Subsoil Thereof, and (e) the Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production and Stockpiling of Bacteriological (Biological) and Toxin Weapons and on Their Destruction.

The United States of America is the depositary of the Antarctic Treaty.

The Secretary-General of the South Pacific Forum Secretariat is the depositary of the South Pacific Nuclear Free Zone Treaty (Treaty of Rarotonga).
